## The Brainstorming Process

Involving creativity, writing, and self-expression!

- o Focus on a single topic.
  - o It might be already decided for you or could be your choice.
  - O If it is up to you, we recommend choosing something you are passionate about, something you are interested in (maybe focus in on why the topic is intriguing)!
- o Begin doing some research (if prohibited) to learn more about your topic.
- o Jot down ideas/sentences that catch your eye or make you reread it.
- Create a graphic organizer (if that is what you like) or a starting basis for your flow of ideas.
- Write down anything thoughts, facts, statistics, questions because you
  might need it in the future!
- o Begin drafting.
  - o The first draft might be scary or intimidating but getting something written on the page is important.
